## RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor:

- Approve the prequalified list of 39 developers (Attachment A List of Prequalified Developers for Housing Development) identified through the Affordable Housing Opportunity Sites (AHOS) Request for Qualifications/Proposals (RFQ/P) for three years plus two one-year extensions;
- Approve the disposition recommendations for the eight city-owned sites, a total of twelve parcels as outlined in Attachment B – List of AHOS – Site Recommendations;

The City called for an RFQ/P, a Request for Qualified Bidders to submit proposals for City-owned lots to be used for homeless, low cost housing, seniors, veterans, and negotiated with these 39 bidders, and awarded projects based on these qualifications.
